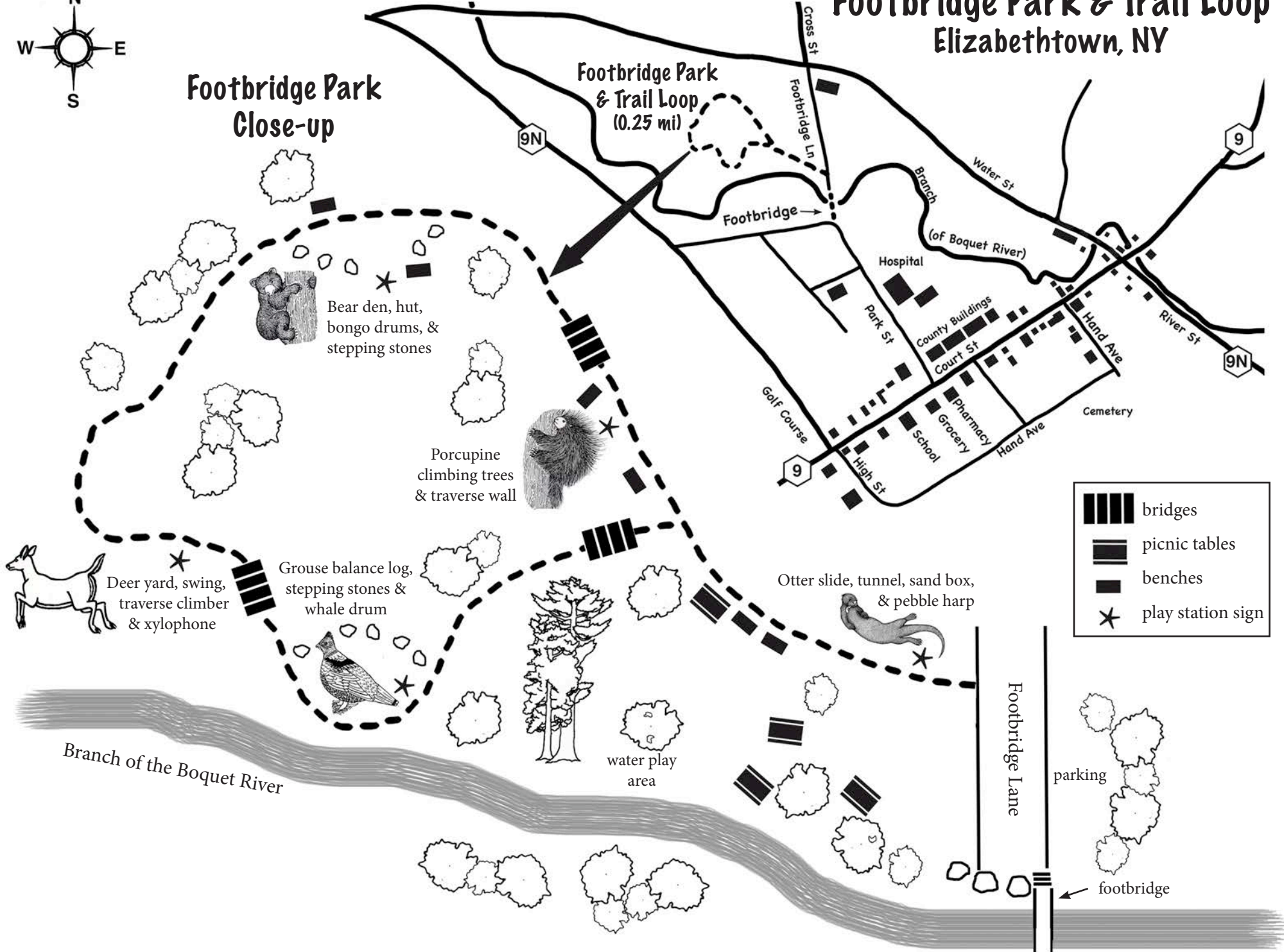

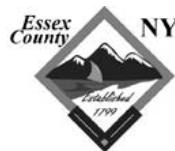
Listen to the wind

Park.

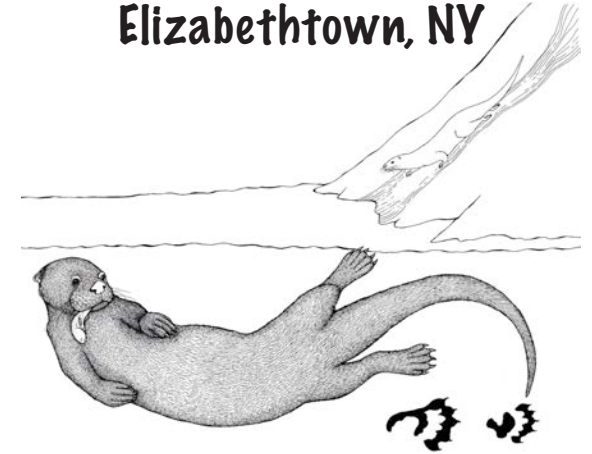

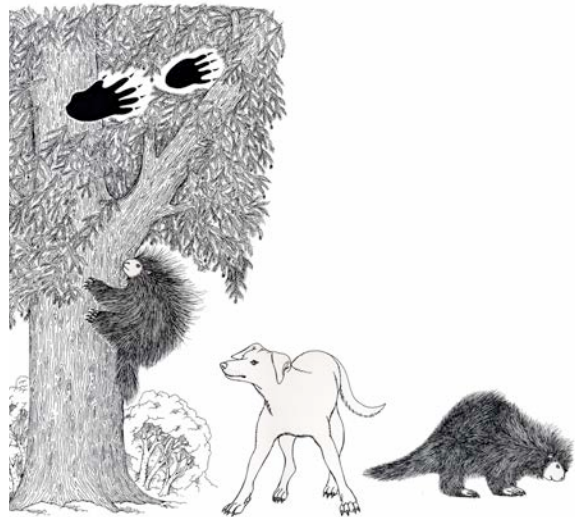
